

The **vision for the Extended learning programme (ELP)**, is that it is an integral part of the Magdalen school curriculum that offers opportunities for learning that cannot be provided without disrupting the normal school day, ie:

- Subject enrichment and extension activities that take learning out of the routine, that are memorable, exciting and inspirational. This might be working on different topics, in different ways, in different groups with different people in different places, than usual.
- Trips and activities for year groups that would disrupt learning if arranged during the school day.
- PCSHE / CIAGS delivery that is not part of normal school lessons, or involves external agencies that can be available to larger groups of students.

The expectation is that ALL students participate in ALL aspects of the extended learning programme, as for any other part of the Magdalen Curriculum. Magdalen will work with parents to remove any barriers to full participation.
