Dear Parent / Carer,

Applying for a Year 7 place in secondary school for September 2021

Your child is due to move on to secondary school in September 2021 having completed the primary phase of their education. You now need to apply for a place at secondary school for your child.

How to apply

The easiest and quickest way to apply is online at: <u>www.northamptonshire.gov.uk/admissions</u> Applications open on 10th September 2020. You will need to register using an email address.

You can also download a copy of the 'Applying for a Secondary School Place in Northamptonshire 2021/22' from the NCC website – this is the prospectus which contains information about all secondary schools in the county. Please read it carefully before making your application.

Alternatively, you can make an application by completing a common application form on paper. You can request an application form from the School Admissions Team (contact details below).

Some schools require you to complete a supplementary information form (SIF) and some also require your child to sit a common ability test (CAT). There is a list of schools which require a SIF on our website. SIFs should be returned <u>directly to the school</u>. It is important to be aware that some schools give priority to children who sit their common ability test, so those who do not will have less chance of getting a place.

Closing date for applications

Your application must reach us by **5 p.m. on 31st October 2020.** Failure to get your application in on time will affect your chances of obtaining a place for your child at your preferred schools.

Pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHC Plan)

If your child has an EHC Plan, you do not need to apply for a school place using the process explained above. Instead, you will receive a letter from the EHC Team seeking details of your school preference.


Pupils living outside Northamptonshire

If your home address is outside Northamptonshire (even if your child attends a Northamptonshire primary / junior school), you should make your application to the local authority where you live (your home local authority), not NCC. Contact details of neighbouring local authorities can be found on our website.
