

Engagement Scores

A 4 for Engagement means:

Regularly exceeding expectations of behaviour.

You behave in a way that consistently enables you and others to learn effectively. You meet all the expectations for grade 3 and:

- You are a confident, independent learner
- You support and enable the progress of others
- You extend your own understanding through proactively seeking help
- You extend your own understanding through discussion and debate, and you do this showing respect for others' ideas and points of view
- You consistently complete all work to a very high standard including accurate, neat presentation of work
- You consistently develop understanding through thorough follow-up to feedback from the teacher and peers.

Regularly exceeding expectations of Homework:

- You produce homework that exceeds expectations because you complete all the work set to a very high standard and extend your work beyond the work that was set.
- All deadlines are met

A 3 for Engagement means:

Meeting expectations of behaviour.

You behave in a way that consistently enables you and others to learn effectively.

- You arrive on time ready to learn
- You have all the correct equipment needed for learning
- You remain on task throughout the lesson
- You do not engage in chatter
- You respond rapidly to instructions from the teacher
- You regularly make appropriate contributions to class and group discussions
- You complete work to a high standard, including accurate, neat presentation of work.

Meeting expectations of Homework:

- You complete all Homework to a high standard and hand it in on time
- You seek help, as necessary, to enable homework to be completed and handed in on time

A 2 for Engagement means:

Sometimes failing to meet expectations of behaviour.

Sometimes you behave in a way that interrupts learning by:

- Engaging in chatter or by being off task
- Failing to engage in class discussion or group discussions productively
- Failing to bring necessary equipment to lessons
- Producing work that is of a lower standard than expected
- Arriving late for lessons
- Being slow to follow instructions or to engage in learning

Sometimes failing to meet expectations of Homework:

- Sometimes, you fail to meet deadlines
- Sometimes, you hand in homework which is of a poorer standard than that expected.

A 1 for Engagement means:

Often failing to meet expectations of behaviour:

- Often producing work that is of a lower standard than expected
- Often arriving late for lessons

Often failing to meet expectations of Homework:

- Often, you fail to meet deadlines
- Often, you hand in homework which is of a poorer standard than that expected.

Any one or more of the above results in a grade 1 for Engagement.
